

Dr Allen Aylett is regarded as the godfather of the North Melbourne Football Club.

Our Patron

Dr ALLEN AYLETT

Recently named the fourth greatest player in the club's history, Aylett played 220 games and kicked 311 goals in a career spanning from 1952–1964.

An extensive list of accolades include Best & Fairest honours from 1958–1960, All-Australian selection in 1958 and 1961, Tassie Medal in 1958, Simpson Medal in 1960, and was captain from 1961–1964. He was selected in North's Team of the Century and elevated to Legend in the Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the AFL Hall of Fame.

After one of the most decorated playing careers in the club's history, he served as club president and was a true pioneer.

His legacy includes the aggressive recruitment of star players to deliver our first premierships, and the creation of the iconic Grand Final Breakfast. He was elected president of the VFL and became one of the most powerful football administrators in the country, influencing the rise of the national competition. His achievements led to him being awarded as Officer of the Order of the British Empire, an Australian Sports Medal and Centenary Medal, and induction into the Sport Australia Hall of Fame.

North Melbourne is delighted to recognise the great Allen Aylett by dedicating the bequest society in his honour. The underlying sentiment from past players, members and fans throughout the club's 150th year celebrations was the enormous impact that Allen had on our club, both as a player and administrator.

The Allen Aylett Bequest Society allows our members and fans to leave a legacy for the future, ensuring the security and success for the club that means so much to so many.

We originated in North Melbourne and with iron-willed determination have fought to remain here as this is where we belong. Belonging is part of what defines us.


Bold

BEQUEST PROGRAM

Unless specifically requested by the donor, all bequest gifts are invested in a long term balanced investment fund. Only income generated from this investment will be used for club operations, meaning your gift will truly live forever.

In the unlikely event that the clubs financial sustainability is critically threatened, the board of directors may approve the use of any amount of the investment fund to protect the club's financial future.

WILLS AND BEQUEST

Having a clear, legally valid and up-to-date Will is the best way to help ensure that your assets are protected and distributed according to your wishes, allowing your legacy to continue for generations.

A bequest is simply an instruction in your Will to leave a gift to a specific person or organisation.

Including the North Melbourne Football Club in your Will is just as easy as providing for your loved ones, and it can be as much or as little as you decide. In making the decision to leave a gift to North Melbourne you make an amazing contribution and ensure your legacy lives on forever, with the team that you have been so passionate about all of your life.

There are many types of bequests and for that reason it is important to seek advice from a solicitor. The main types include:



The residue (remainder) of your estate after you have made provisions for family and other beneficiaries



A percentage of your estate



A set amount of money



A specific asset (e.g. property, artwork, shares)

A percentage bequest is the most popular for many donors. This is due to the gift not being affected by inflation or changes in the value of your estate.

YOUR WILL

Making or changing a Will is a simple and inexpensive procedure, whilst also being essential to protect your legacy. You can change your Will, in consultation with your family and a solicitor, by simply adding the North Melbourne Football Club through a legal amendment known as a codicil.

When deciding upon your Will we encourage you to consider family, friends, charities and the North Melbourne Football Club.

We also understand that circumstances change, and should you change your mind after making a gift to the club, we understand. We encourage you to keep us informed along the way should you be inclined to do so.

NEXT STEPS

I want to leave a gift to the North Melbourne Football Club, what next?

1. If you do not have a Will, you will need to create one with the help of a solicitor.
2. If you do have a Will, all that is required is to add a codicil, which is a short legal amendment to your existing Will. The club can assist with providing a template codicil drafted by our legal counsel.
3. Make a decision on the type of bequest you would like to leave (refer to page 8).
4. Discuss this decision with your family so they are aware and understand the reason for your gift.
5. Advise the club if there is a specific area of the club you would like this gift to be directed towards.
6. Notify the club of your intention to leave a gift in your Will. We will always respect your privacy and confidentiality, but we would like to acknowledge your generous contribution.

SUGGESTED WORDING

We encourage you to work with your solicitor to ensure your Will is correct, with the below to be used as a general guide.

Residue


